

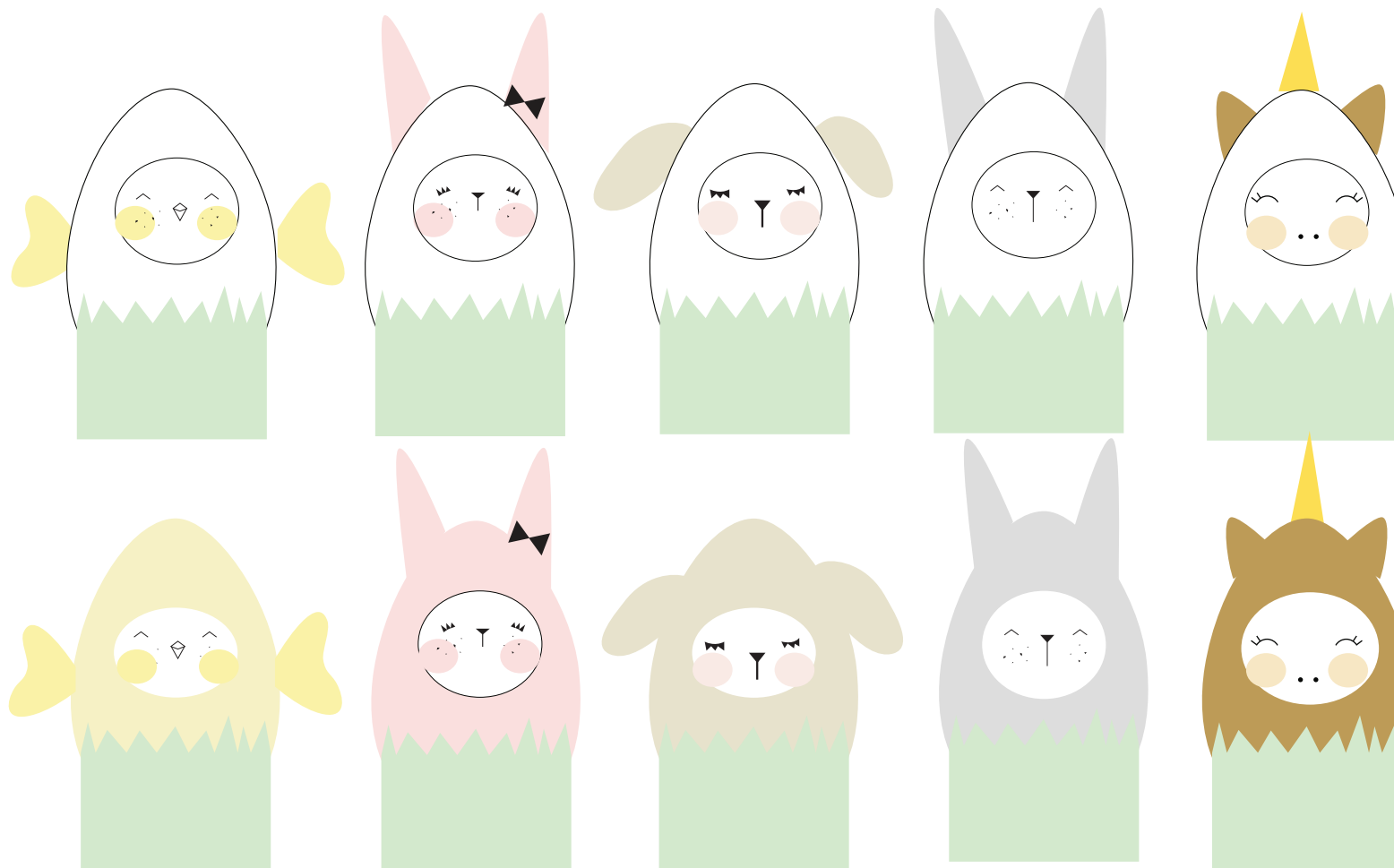


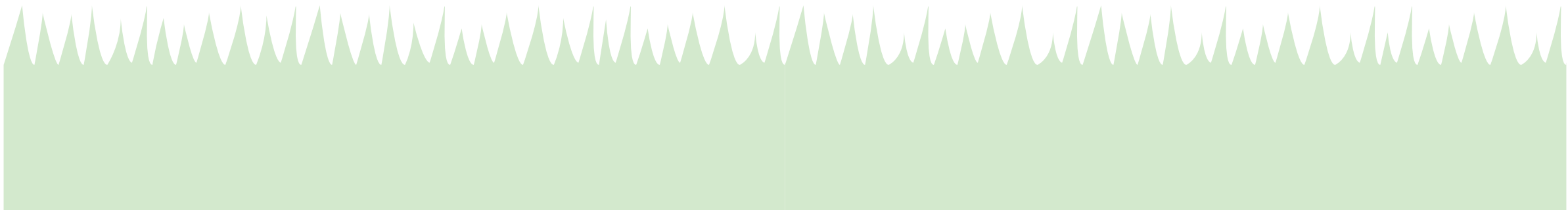
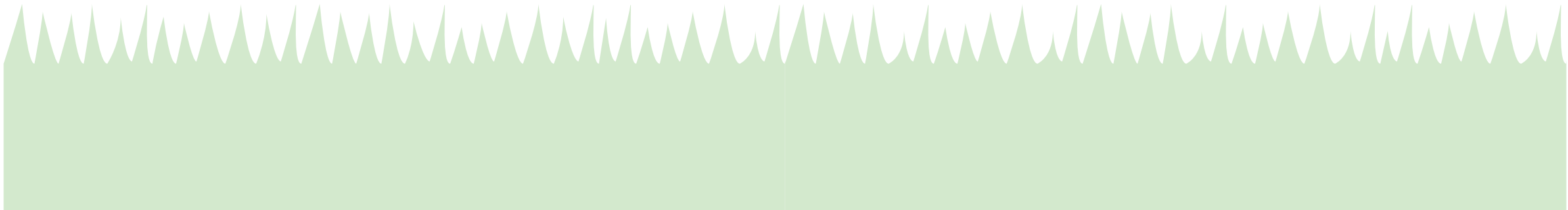
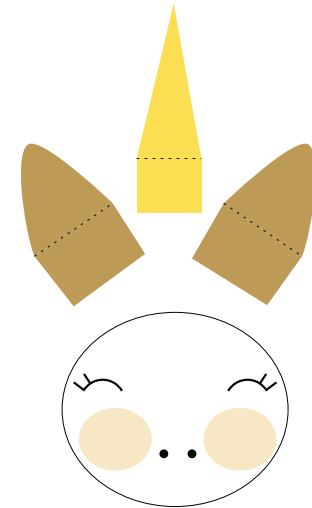
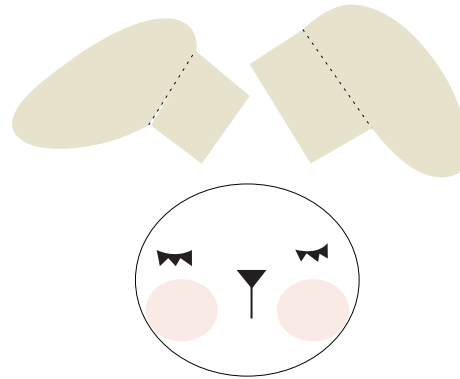
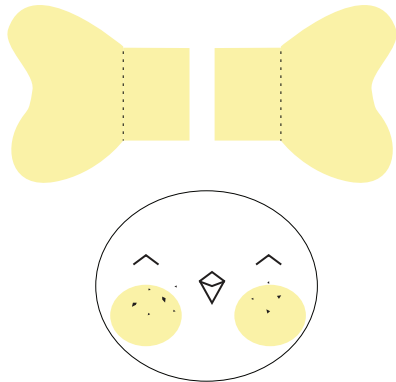
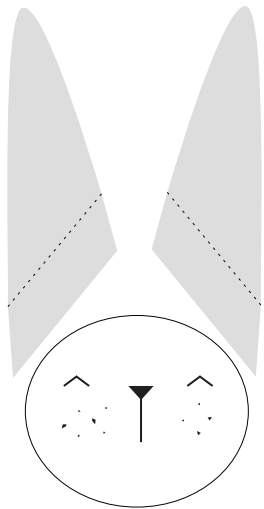
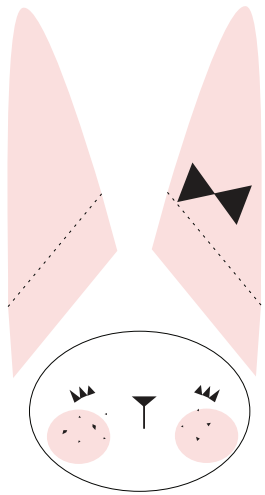
EASTER EGG FRIENDS

Note: You will need 5 hard boiled eggs for this activity. Boil them and let them cool before using. Once you've printed this, start by cutting out the faces and ears on the next page along with the grass. After you've cut out the grass, cut it into five equal sections. When everything is cut out, fold the ears on each of the dotted lines. Then glue the faces and ears onto each egg. Finish by gluing the grass to the bases of the eggs, creating sweet little Easter Egg Friends!

TIP:

Dip die or paint each egg with a pretty Easter colour before gluing on the faces and ears. Use feathers, markers or beads for an extra dash of creativity!

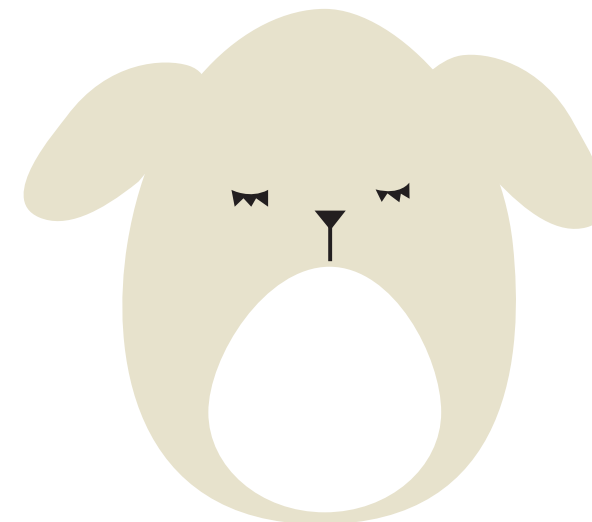
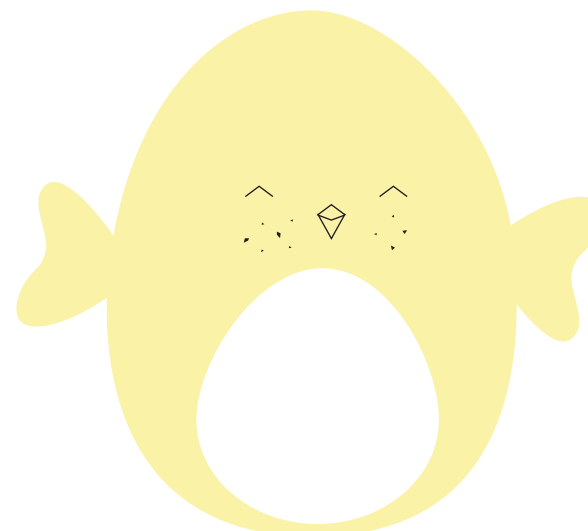
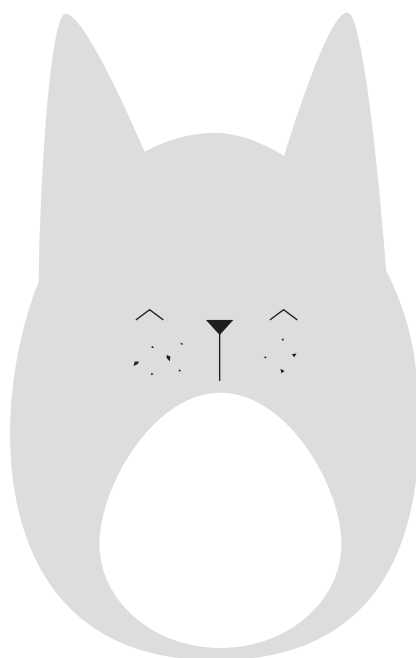
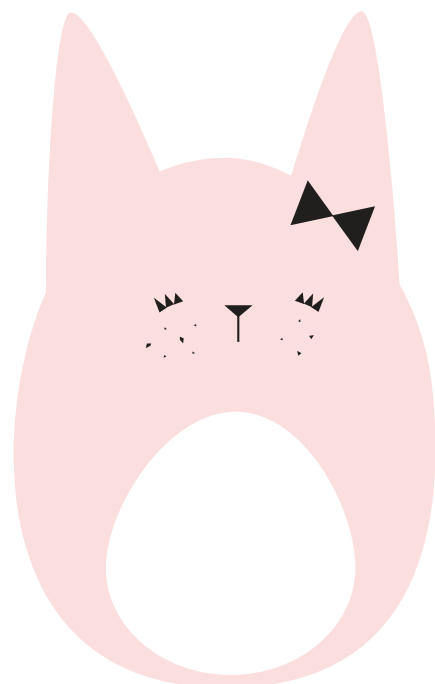
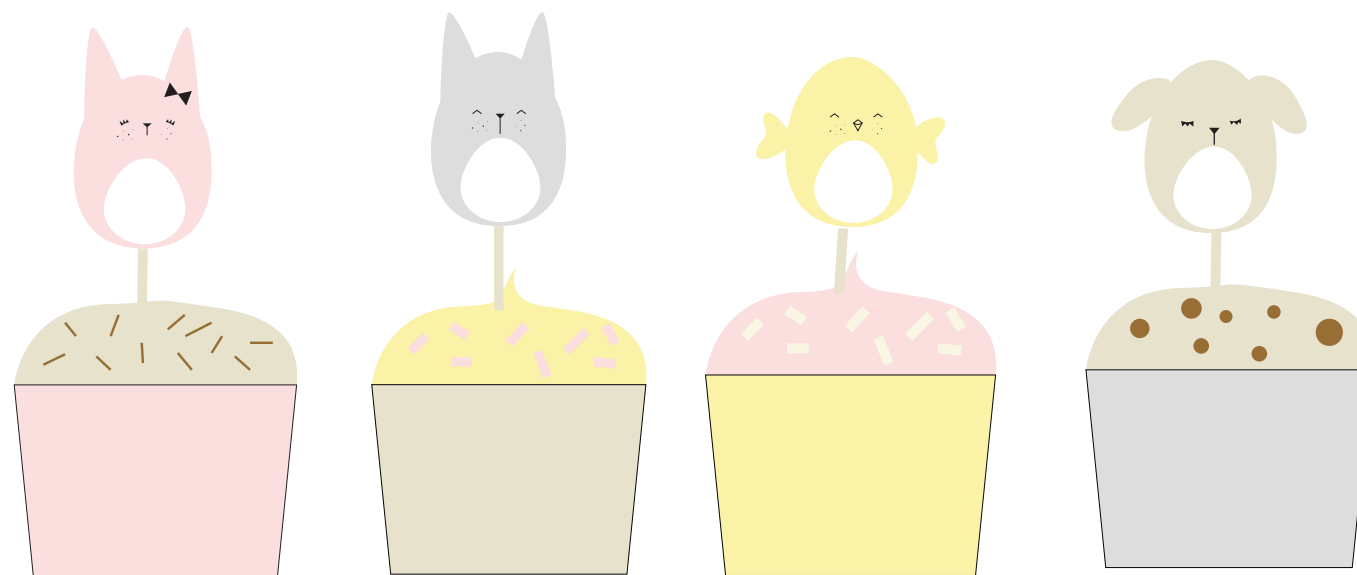


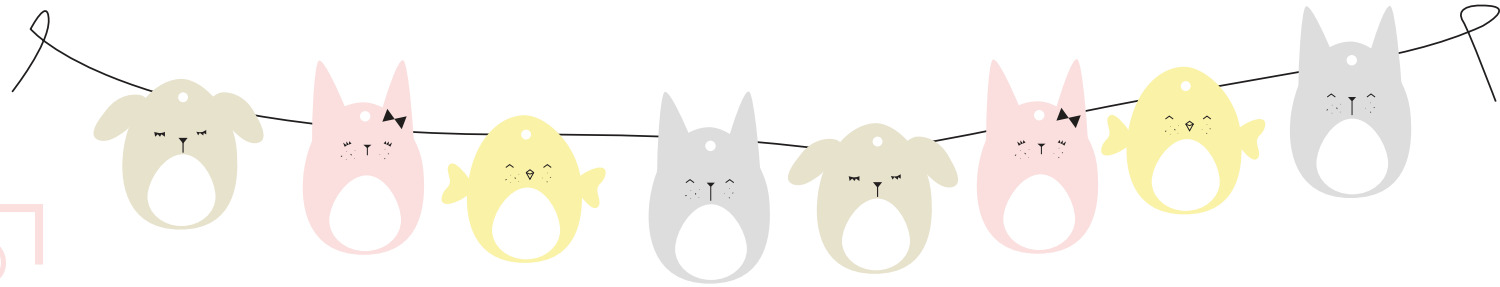




EASTER FRIENDS CAKE TOPPERS
